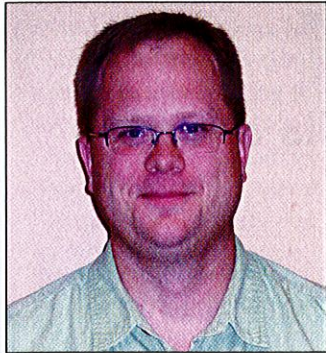


Check Us Out Online

The new and improved www.renville-sibley.coop is live and ready for visitors. The new website is designed to be more streamlined, useful and interactive.
