

4. Right now, Renville-Sibley Co-op Power is trying to balance environmental goals with reliability and affordability. Are you concerned that the Clean Power Plan and additional proposed regulations in Minnesota will tip this balance away from affordability for our members?

Miller: Yes I am. I am disturbed that Minnesota is the only state in our region that is pressing forward with the Clean Power Plan, even trying to exceed those standards, while there is a federal lawsuit which may make it null and void. It is manipulative of the system, it places us at odds with our state neighbors, and will eventually make energy way more expensive for our communities.
